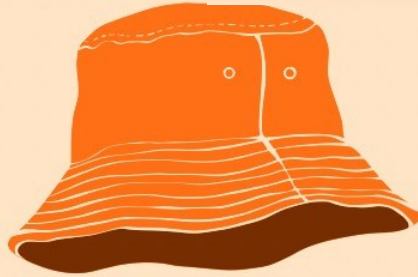
Throughout the day students will be participating in a variety of special football related activities. If your child has a football at home, please allow them to bring this to school with their name clearly marked on it.

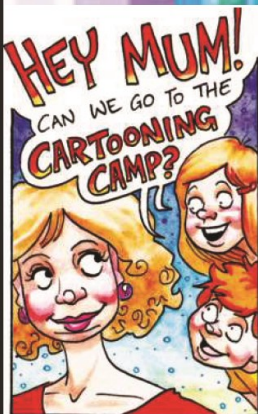

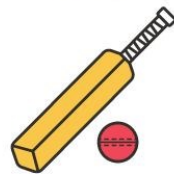
