




At Aspendale Gardens Primary School, we aim to develop students' skills through engagement in different devices and operating systems throughout their schooling. This includes iPad's with iOS, laptops, 2 in 1 tablets and desktop computers with Microsoft Windows. We have allocated the devices to particular year levels with the purpose of having students develop their ICT skills across their schooling in a logical manner.

We provide opportunities for students to develop their skills in Robotics and Coding through the use of Bee Bots, Sphero's, Lego We Do 2.0 and Lego EV3 Mindstorms. These skills are developed in coordination with their Units of Inquiry to help students make connections between how coding skills can be used in real life.

Over the summer holidays we have begun to update the Interactive Whiteboards within our classrooms. We have just installed 8 brand new ViewSonic 75 inch Interactive Touchscreens into our Year 2 and Year 5 classrooms (see pictures below). These devices give teachers the opportunity to provide students with more creative and engaging lessons. We have budgeted for more classrooms to have this upgrade in 2022 and look forward to our students benefiting from the new technology.




